2.3. Consortium page

This page provides the partners description that are consortium part.

Each partner information is in a box, in which there is the logo, name, acronym, country and the social networks icons of each one to be able to easily navigate to each partner particular information. In addition, there is a map with the exact each partner location.

2.4. Sister projects page

Here the projects that are directly related to the HEROES project are listed, the logo is displayed, a brief description and a direct link when clicking on the image that automatically redirects to the web page of each project.

2.5. News page

This page aims to present the latest news related to the HEROES project; in this first section you will find the most recent news.
